Although Scandinavia has not been known historically as a big wine producing region due to its cold climate inhospitable to viticulture, things are shifting rapidly as the climate patterns change around the world.

Vexebo Vin - Fredensborg, Denmark

Founded by Daniel Milan in 2007 with just 1 hectare under vines, Vexebo Vin focuses on hybrid grape varieties that can survive in a place that sits on the same latitude with Scotland's Edinburgh. A pioneer of organic viticulture in Denmark, Daniel makes delicious natural wines that are unlike anything else we've tasted.

In addition to sauvignier gris, they also grow solaris, muscaris, and johannites, as well as the blue grape varieties pinot nova, cabernet noir, rondo and regent
