Nordic Wines

Although Scandinavia has not been known historically as a big wine producing region due to its cold climate inhospitable to viticulture, things are shifting rapidly as the climate patterns change around the world.

Vexebo Vin: Fredensborg, Denmark

Founded by Daniel Milan in 2007 with just 1 hectare under vines, Vexebo Vin focuses on hybrid grape varieties that can survive in a place that sits on the same latitude with Scotland's Edinburgh. A pioneer of organic viticulture in Denmark, Daniel makes delicious natural wines that are unlike anything else we've tasted.

Kullabergs Vingård: Scania, Sweden

Kullabergs Vingård comprises 14 hectares of vineyards distributed over three vineyard locations. The first vines were planted in 2006. At that time, the plantations consisted of one hectare. In addition to sauvignier gris, they also grow solaris, donauriesling, muscaris, auxerrois and johannites, as well as the blue grape varieties pinot nova, cabernet noir, rondo, regent.

Since 2011, Hernö has been at the forefront of Swedish craft gin. Located in the village of Dala near Härnösand in the High Coast, Hernö uses natural organic botanicals distilled in hand-hammered copper stills to create some of the world's most acclaimed gins.
