Nordic Wines

Although Scandinavia has not been known historically as a big wine producing region due to its cold climate inhospitable to viticulture, things are shifting rapidly as the climate patterns change around the world. In this section you'll find a few unique bottles that will give you a glimpse into the up and coming vineyards of the region.

Vexebo Vin: Fredensborg, Denmark

Founded by Daniel Milan in 2007 with just 1 hectare under vines, Vexebo Vin focuses on hybrid grape varieties that can survive in a place that sits on the same latitude with Scotland's Edinburgh. A pioneer of organic viticulture in Denmark, Daniel makes delicious natural wines that are unlike anything else we've tasted.

Hernö Gin Distillery

Hernö has been pioneering craft gin in Sweden since 2011. Located in the small village of Dala just outside Härnösand in the High Coast of Sweden, Hernö is crafting some of the world's most awarded gins from natural organic botanicals carefully distilled in the hand hammered copper stills.
